SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES 2010

The Scholarship has been established by the Rosary Altar Society of Our Lady of Lourdes Parish, Whitehouse Station, NJ for the purpose of giving financial assistance to the students of registered families of the parish.

\$500.00 will be given to a boy &/or girl each year, provided applications are received and the guidelines are met. Awards will be given to high school graduates who have been accepted to a four or two year college, vocational school or community college.

Applicants may obtain an application for the scholarship form the parish office Monday through Friday between the hours of 9:00AM – 4:00PM.

The scholarship committee will decide the recipient of the scholarship based on:

- a) Applicant's statements of parish community service,
- b) Personnel essay,
- c) Letter of recommendation from parish staff
- d) List of other school/community activities.

The application must be filled out and signed by the applicant and returned to the parish office in care of the Rosary Altar Society scholarship committee no later than the Friday, April 23, 2010. ***The application will be deemed incomplete without all necessary items. An incomplete application will NOT be considered for the scholarship regardless of need or qualifications.***

When final action has been taken on the application, a copy of the application, with a letter indication the action by the committee will be sent to the corresponding secretary of the Rosary Altar Society as a matter of record. The Pastor of Our Lady of Lourdes will give final approval to the scholarship committee for scholarship recipients. All applications will be given to the President to place in the scholarship file of the Rosary Altar Society.

The scholarship check will be made out to the applicant and the award will be presented at the June Meeting of the Rosary Altar Society. If the applicant is unable to attend the meeting, the check will be mailed to him/her or given to their designate. An announcement of the winner(s) will be placed in the church bulletin.
